
28 1/4 Rd and Hawthorne Ave Intersection Construction

Description

This is a notification to all affected residences and businesses that the City of Grand Junction will be constructing the intersection of 28 1/4 Road and Hawthorne Avenue. The connection of 28 1/4 Road to Hawthorne Avenue provides an important link as part of the City's planned transportation network that would allow residential traffic to use 28 1/4 to access Patterson Road. This connection has been advanced in the City's capital improvement plan to reduce traffic on 28 Road and allow eastbound traffic to turn left at the signalized intersection at 28 1/4 Road as a safer alternative. The extension of 28 1/4 Road to the north of Patterson Road is a collector roadway that will ultimately be one of the main access points for Matchett Park once it is developed.

Schedule/Hours of Operation

Work is anticipated to begin in mid-February 2022 with the work planned to take 3 months to complete once underway.
Hours of Operations: 7:00 am—5 pm, Monday thru Friday. Occasionally, there may be some weekend work.

COVID-19

Our contractor will be utilizing current, approved, safety measures regarding the COVID-19 situation. These may or may not change based on the up-to-date, approved measures at the time of construction.

Trash/Mail Delivery

Trash pick-up and mail delivery should remain as normal.

The City of Grand Junction is pleased to announce that M.A. Concrete Construction, Inc. of Grand Junction has been awarded the construction contract.

Traffic Impacts/Access

During construction, pedestrian access to the Matchett Park area may be somewhat limited. The Contractor will allow foot traffic too access the park as able, but there may be select days when it is not possible. When placing concrete or asphalt, residents or business closest to the site may be temporarily impacted by a reduced access to driveways, as well as heavier truck traffic in the area. Any residences directly impacted will be notified by door hanger or contacted by the contractor 48 hours prior to disruption.
